



AUDITIONS AND CASTING INFORMATION

Important Details: *You must be registered for the production before auditioning. Everyone who auditions is guaranteed a role.*

AUDITION INFORMATION:

For auditions, we ask that you prepare a 1-minute song. The song can be sung acapella or with a non-vocal backing track from your own device. The song must be pop, from a musical, a Disney hit, or from the production selections below.

Easy: “It’s A Hard-Knock Life”

Moderate: “Tomorrow”

Difficult: “N.Y.C”

CALLBACKS:

Callbacks will be held after auditions are complete. If you are called back, you will be asked to read and/or sing sides from the script. Please note that only selected participants will be called back.

CASTING ANNOUNCEMENT:

The cast list will be announced via email the day after auditions. It takes an ensemble to make a show, and everyone’s part is important to the outcome of the production.

MARK YOUR CALENDAR: If there is a conflict and your child cannot attend certain rehearsal dates please inform the Producing Artistic Director, Tish Poorman or the Director, Kristin Bihler.

OTHER INFORMATION:

- Children must wear closed toe shoes and comfortable clothing.
- Bring the script and a pencil to every rehearsal.
- No food or drink is allowed (except water) in the theater during rehearsals.
- Parents must wait for their children to be dismissed and may not attend auditions or rehearsals so that all focus can be put into the production. This policy allows children to have total artistic freedom.
